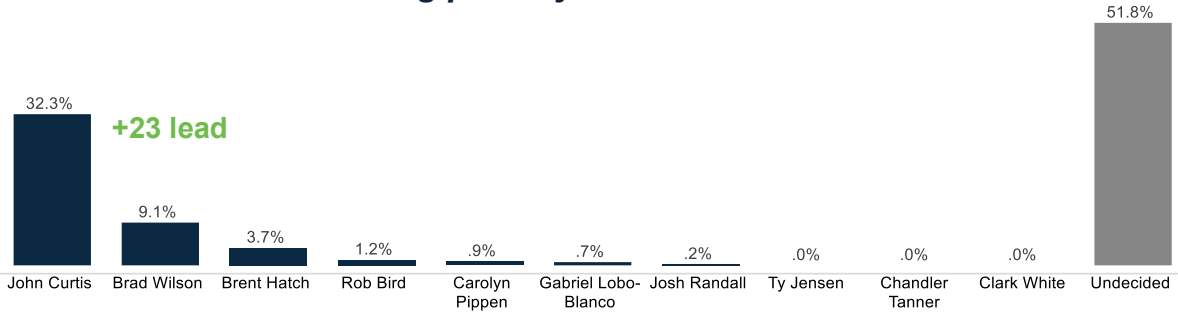




# John Curtis Leads UT Senate Primary with Energy Message

## John Curtis holds commanding primary lead for U.S. Senate in Utah.

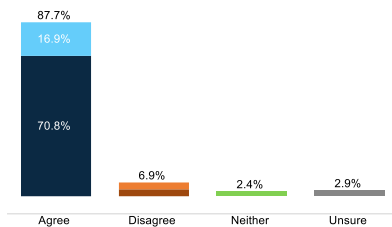


- John Curtis (+30 net fav; 59% hard name ID) is off to a commanding lead (32%). No other candidate cracks double digits. 52% are still undecided.
- Curtis is especially popular (+55 net favorable) with high-propensity (4 of 4) Republican primary voters.

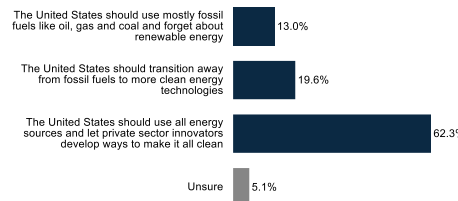
## Utah GOP primary voters are responding to John Curtis’s energy messaging.

- 88% of Republican primary voters agree we must utilize our natural resources to develop domestic energy.
- 62% agree the U.S. should use ALL energy sources, compared to the fringes on each side of going all-in or abandoning fossil fuels.
- 65% agree clean energy is an issue Republicans in Congress should care about, over 3:1 margin to those who disagree (21%).

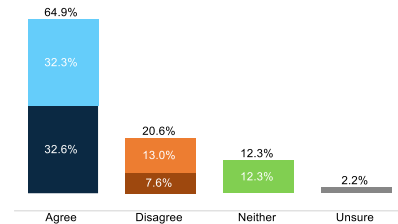

**Methodology:** This probabilistic survey was conducted January 23 – 24, 2024, with 500 likely Republican primary election voters. It has a margin of error of ±4.38%. Known registered voters were interviewed via live calls and text-to-web. This survey was weighted to a likely Republican primary election voter universe.
